Nearby, kids can view lethal snakes becoming reluctant altruists at the antivenin-producing Queen Saovabha Memorial Institute, aka the Snake Farm.

## PRACTICAL AREA INFORMATION LOCAL CONDITIONS

### STAYING SAFE ADVICE

Bangkok is generally a safe city, but there are a few things to be aware of:.

- Criticising the Thai monarchy in any way is a very serious social faux pas that carries potentially incriminating repercussions; don't do it.

- Avoid the common scams: one-day gem sales, suspiciously low transport prices, dodgy tailors.

- Bangkok's streets are extremely dangerous and its drivers rarely yield to pedestrians. Look in both directions before crossing any street (or footpath) and yield to anything with more metal than you.

- Most of Bangkok's street-food vendors close shop on Monday.

- Bangkok's rainy season is from May to October, when daily downpours – and occasional flooding – are the norm.

- Although it's deemed potable by the authorities, Thais don't drink tap water and neither should you. Stick to bottled or filtered water during your stay.

### WEATHER INFORMATION

Bangkok, Thailand: Annual Weather Averages April is the hottest month in Bangkok with an average temperature of  $31^{\circ}C(87^{\circ}F)$  and the coldest is December at  $26^{\circ}C(79^{\circ}F)$  with the most daily sunshine hours at 9 in December. The wettest month is September with an average of 220mm of rain. The best month to swim in the sea is in April when the average sea temperature is  $30^{\circ}C(86^{\circ}F)$ . ### AIRPORT

Airport transfer by private car @600 THB/way (inclusive the toll fee) about 1 hr. for normal traffic. Or you may take the BTS and connect to AIRPORT RAIL LINK via MAKKASAN STATION.

### BANK / ATM

The nearest bank and ATM is in the LOTUS SUPERMARTKET, just 5 min walk from the house

### CHURCH

**ST.LOUIS CHRUCH** is the nearest church, by BTS SALA DANG **ASSUMPTION CATHEDRAL** by bus and BTS SATHORN STATION The French built Assumption Cathedral, an old Catholic church in Bangkok opposite the famous Oriental Hotel, not far from the French Embassy. Brainchild of a French missionary, Father Pascal in 1809 and creation of a French architect, the cathedral was completed in 1821, in the reign of King Rama II.

### **GROCERY STORE**

The nearest one is TESCO LOTUS, just opposite the house ,100 metre or Seven Eleven ( Convenience Store ) open 24 hours, just take 5 minutes to the Shop.

### Trip around neighborhood of Pariya Villa

*Tell us about our favorite neighborhood in Bangkok, what do you like about it?* Staying at Pariya Villa, guests can go to most of interesting places on foot. Bangkok has a rich culture and history that you can admire by visiting its art galleries museums. Art Gallery and Museum Walking Tour is one of the most enjoyable activities. Around Pariya Villa's neighborhood, there are cluster of both public galleries and private galleries dotted in Patthumwan subdistict, Siam Square and the vicinity of Chulalongkorn University. You can spend the whole day roam about this small area. Just to name a few, Bangkok Metropolitan Museum of Contemporary Art (BMOCA), Jim Thomson House and its Art Center, Jamjuri Art Gallery of Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok Seashell Museum, Madame Tussauds Bangkok and more.

What'd you do if you have three days in Bangkok?

Which part of Bangkok/Thailand do you want to introduce to young travelers? See more Art Galleries and Museums further in the old town of Bangkok around the Grand Palace from Pariya Villa you can easily take a public bus or three wheelers cab so called "Tuk-Tuk" which will take about 10-20mins depending on the traffic. Late at night in wee hours of 3.00am until dawn guests can explore buzzing river-sided flower market. If you want to see Thailand water communities, taking boat trips along the Chao Phraya River and its many canals like Klong Bangkok Noi also make a stop at the mouth of this canal to check out Thai Railway Museum right next to Siriraj Hospital is worth visiting.

One of the many advantages staying at Pariya Villa is close to the central train terminal "Hua Lumpong" the young travelers probably want to go out of town for a one day trip by train. For instance, go to former Siam capital, Ayutthaya to see UNESCO world heritage archeological sites and look in on the Chao Sam Phraya museum. For artists and art lovers, town of Ayutthaya is a great place for on-site landscape painting pastime. Upon request here at Pariya Villa or other places, we can arrange art workshop led by seasoned Thai artists to learn Thai culture through paintings portraying river villages, floating market, rice-fields scene and fishing boats of rural Thailand as well as tropical fauna and flora, such as Lotus flowers, orchids and up to artists' own imaginations. *Can you share tips to live like local in your neighborhood?* 

Walk or take public transportation, eat street food or cook it yourself. Here at Pariya Villa we can hold easy cooking class for Thai food. You cannot do this if make overnight stay in the hotel or in the suburban.
